I. Focus on China

(I) Two Sessions

1. China's top political advisory body starts annual session



China's top political advisory body, the Chinese People's Political Consultative Conference (CPPCC), started its annual session on March 4 in Beijing. Xi Jinping and other Chinese leaders attended the opening meeting of the 5th session of the 13th CPPCC National Committee, held at the Great Hall of the People.

Wang Yang, chairman of the CPPCC National Committee, delivered a work

report of the Standing Committee of the CPPCC National Committee to the session.

The CPPCC National Committee and its standing committee have performed their duties with a focus on getting the 14th Five-Year Plan off to a good start, further built the CPPCC as a special consultative body to improve the performance of the CPPCC system, and made new contributions to the cause of the Party and the country, Wang said.

In 2022, the CPPCC committees will see their work revolving around the 20th National Congress of the Communist Party of China (CPC), said Wang. He urged contributions to maintaining a stable and sound economic environment, a social climate enabling prosperity for the people and the country, and a healthy political atmosphere of integrity.

Attendees were also briefed on the handling of proposals submitted by political advisors.

A total of 6,117 proposals have been submitted, according to Liu Xincheng, vice chairman of the CPPCC National Committee.

2. China's national legislature opens annual session

China's national legislature, the National People's Congress (NPC), opened its annual session on March 5 in Beijing. Chinese leaders Xi Jinping, Li Keqiang, Wang Yang, Wang Huning, Zhao Leji, Han Zheng and Wang Qishan attended the opening meeting of the fifth session of the 13th NPC, held at the Great Hall of the People.

Li Zhanshu, executive chairperson of the presidium for the session, presided over the meeting.

Premier Li Keqiang delivered a government work report on behalf of the State Council to the legislature for deliberation.

In his report, the premier reviewed the government work in 2021, and introduced the overall requirements and policy orientation for economic and social development in 2022.



Hailing the year of 2021 as a milestone, the premier said that the country worked hard as one and once again secured new and major achievements in its development in the past year in the face of complicated and challenging circumstances both in and outside of China, as well as many risks and challenges.

"While recognizing our achievements, we are also very clear about the problems and challenges before us," he said, stressing the need to face problems and challenges squarely, and do the utmost to live up to people's expectations.

A raft of targets were set for the country's development in 2022 in the government work report, including a GDP growth of around 5.5 percent, more than 11 million new urban jobs, and a consumer price index increase of around 3 percent.

The report also listed major tasks for 2022, including achieving stable macroeconomic performance, maintaining job security, deepening reform, and expanding high-level opening up.

NPC deputies reviewed the report on the implementation of the 2021 plan and on the 2022 draft plan for national economic and social development, and the draft plan for national economic and social development in 2022; the report on the

execution of the central and local budgets for 2021 and on the draft central and local budgets for 2022, and the draft central and local budgets for 2022.

Wang Chen, vice chairman of the NPC Standing Committee, expounded a draft amendment to the Organic Law of the Local People's Congresses and Local People's Governments, which has been submitted to national lawmakers for review.

Wang also delivered an explanatory speech on a draft decision on the number of deputies to the 14th NPC and their election.

In accordance with the Constitution and relevant laws, the election of deputies to the 14th NPC shall be completed in January 2023 before the incumbent 13th NPC deputies finish their term of office in March 2023, Wang said.

Wang also explained draft methods for the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region (SAR) and the Macao SAR to elect their deputies to the 14th NPC.

3. Xi stresses ethnic unity, strengthening sense of community for Chinese nation

Chinese President Xi Jinping on March 5 stressed ethnic unity and efforts to forge a strong sense of community for the Chinese nation when he joined a deliberation during the annual session of the National People's Congress, the top legislature.


Joining discussions with fellow lawmakers from north China's Inner Mongolia Autonomous Region, Xi, also general secretary of the Communist Party of China (CPC) Central Committee and chairman of the Central Military Commission, hailed ethnic unity as the "lifeline" of Chinese people of all ethnic groups.

He called for efforts to help all ethnic groups stay closely united "like the seeds of a pomegranate that stick together" in jointly building the great motherland.

Efforts should be made to maintain a steady and healthy economic environment, a prosperous and secure social environment, and a clean and healthy

political environment, Xi said, calling for concrete actions to pave the way for the 20th CPC National Congress.

5. China's top political advisory body wraps up annual session

Wang Yang, a member of the Standing Committee of the Political Bureau of the Communist Party of China (CPC) Central Committee and chairman of the National Committee of the CPPCC, presided over the meeting.

A resolution on a work report of the Standing Committee of the CPPCC National Committee, a resolution on a report on how the proposals from political advisors have been handled since the previous annual session, a report on the examination of new proposals, and a political resolution on the fifth session of the 13th CPPCC National Committee were approved at the meeting.

Addressing the meeting, Wang Yang called on political advisors to center on the 20th CPC National Congress which will be convened in the second half of 2022, and make contributions to a stable and healthy economic environment, social

stability and political integrity.

6. China's top legislature wraps up annual session

The 13th National People's Congress (NPC), China's top legislature, concluded its fifth session on March 11.

Chinese leaders Xi Jinping, Li Keqiang, Wang Yang, Wang Huning, Zhao Leji, Han Zheng and Wang Qishan attended the closing meeting of the session at the Great Hall of the People in Beijing.

Li Zhanshu, an executive chairperson of the presidium for the session, presided over the meeting attended by 2,758 NPC deputies.

Lawmakers voted to adopt a decision on amending the Organic Law of the Local People's Congresses and Local People's Governments.

President Xi Jinping signed a presidential order to promulgate the decision.

The meeting adopted a decision on the quota and election of deputies to the 14th NPC, the method for the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region (SAR) to elect its deputies to the 14th NPC, as well as the method for the Macao SAR. According to the decision, the election of deputies shall be completed in January 2023.

Lawmakers approved the government work report and the work reports of the NPC Standing Committee, the Supreme People's Court and the Supreme People's Procuratorate.

They approved a report on the implementation of the 2021 plan for national economic and social development and on the draft plan for 2022, as well as the

2022 plan.

They also approved a report on the execution of the central and local budgets for 2021 and on the draft central and local budgets for 2022, and approved the central budget for 2022.



Addressing the meeting, Li Zhanshu said that the annual session has successfully completed its agenda.

He lauded the achievements made by the 13th NPC and its standing committee, as well as the contributions made by NPC deputies.

Li called for efforts to study and implement Xi's important thoughts on upholding and improving the people's congress system, to uphold the overall leadership of the Communist Party of China (CPC), and to give full play to the role of people's congress system as an important institution for practicing the whole-process people's democracy.

He also called for concrete actions to pave the way for the 20th CPC National Congress.

7. Premier Li Keqiang meets the press



The Fifth Session of the 13th National People's Congress held a press conference at the Great Hall of the People on March 11, 2022. Premier Li Keqiang met with Chinese and foreign reporters and answered their questions at the invitation of Spokesperson Mr. Zhang Yesui.

When answering a reporter's question about foreign investors' concern that China might put more restrictions on corporate behaviors because of the goal of common prosperity, Premier Li Keqiang said that China's opening-up policy will not change "just as the course of the Yangtze and Yellow rivers will not be reversed".

No matter how the international environment may change, China will keep the course of wider openness, Premier Li told reporters.

As more than 40 years of opening-up has brought mutual benefits to China and the world, Premier Li described the policy as a "door of opportunity". China

will not and must not close it, he added.

On March 7, 2022, a press conference was held via video link on the margins of the Fifth Session of the 13th National People's Congress at the Great Hall of the People, during which State Councilor and Foreign Minister Wang Yi answered questions from Chinese and foreign media about China's foreign policy and external relations.

When answering a reporter's question about China-Africa relations, Wang Yi said that over the years, China has built over 10,000 kilometers of railways, up to 100,000 kilometers of highways, nearly 100 ports, and innumerable hospitals and schools in Africa, and that these are not "debt traps", but monuments of cooperation.

He mapped out three priorities for China and Africa to work together in implementation of the deliverables of the Eighth Ministerial Conference of the

Forum on China-Africa Cooperation (FOCAC) held late last year.

First, China will vigorously advance anti-COVID cooperation with Africa.

Second, China will further upgrade its practical cooperation with Africa by accelerating high-quality Belt and Road cooperation and working for early harvests under the nine programs.

Third, China will act on the Outlook on Peace and Development in the Horn of Africa.

Chinese President Xi Jinping on March 17 chaired a leadership meeting on

fighting COVID-19, in which he stressed science-based and accurate measures and the adherence to the dynamic zero-COVID policy to curb the spread of the epidemic soonest.

Top epidemiologists hailed this meeting as injecting the much-needed "anchoring energy" into China's COVID-19 prevention work as it currently battles the "worst outbreaks" in two years caused by the highly contagious Omicron variant. They believed that as China adheres to its dynamic zero-COVID strategy, which is still the biggest advantage China currently has in its COVID-19 battle, the country is also stepping into a "more balanced and scientific" stage of fighting the virus, following the plan drawn by the new COVID-19 playbook.

13. CPC central authorities hear report on handling MU5735 crash and make follow-up arrangements



The Standing Committee of the Political Bureau of the Communist Party of China Central Committee convened a meeting on March 31 to hear a report on handling the crash of the China Eastern Airlines flight MU5735 aircraft on March 21 and make arrangements for the follow-up work. Xi Jinping, general secretary of the CPC Central Committee, presided over the meeting and delivered a speech.

The CPC Central Committee has attached great importance to the crash after it took place, and Xi has delivered important instructions immediately. He stressed

that the emergency response mechanism should be initiated straight away, no effort be spared in search and rescue, and the aftermath be properly handled. He said that the cause must be identified as early as possible, and support and service be provided to families of the victims.

A Boeing 737-800 passenger jetliner with 132 people on board crashed into a mountainous area in southern China's Guangxi Zhuang Autonomous Region on March 21.

The crashed plane, operated by China Eastern Airlines, was flying from Kunming, the capital city of southwest China's Yunnan Province, to Guangzhou, capital of the southern Guangdong Province. The plane lost contact while flying over the city of Wuzhou, the Civil Aviation Administration of China (CAAC) confirmed.

All 132 people on board were dead, and the two black boxes have been recovered. The handling of the aftermath and investigations into the accident are in progress.

14. China's economic recovery "better than expected" in the first two months of this year



China's economic recovery was "better than expected" in the January-February period this year, as retail sales, industrial output and investment all unexpectedly picked up pace, official data showed on March 15.

The country's industrial output went up by 7.5 percent in the period as compared with the figure from a year ago, according to data from the National Bureau of Statistics (NBS). The figure is also up from a gain of 4.3 percent in December last year, beating Reuters' forecast of a 3.9-percent surge.

China's imports and exports both registered double-digit growth in the first two months. The total value of goods imports and exports hit 6.2 trillion yuan (\$972.8 billion), up by 13.3 percent year on year. The trade surplus stood at 738.8 billion yuan.

15. President Xi Jinping holds a virtual summit with leaders of France and Germany



On March 8, President Xi Jinping had a virtual summit with French President Emmanuel Macron and German Chancellor Olaf Scholz in Beijing, supporting

France and Germany in promoting a balanced, effective and sustainable European security framework for the interests and lasting security of Europe.

Xi emphasized the need to jointly support the peace talks between Russia and Ukraine, while encouraging the two sides to maintain the momentum of negotiations and calling for maximum restraint to prevent a massive humanitarian crisis.

The virtual meeting was held on the heels of the third round of negotiations between Ukraine and Russia, which reportedly ended with no major moves toward ending the 12-day military operation. The latest talks among the leaders of China, France and Germany were about a week after Xi held a crucial phone call with Russian President Vladimir Putin.

17. Xi has candid, in-depth exchange of views with Biden



On March 18, Chinese President Xi Jinping had a video call with U.S. President Joe Biden at the request of the latter. The two Presidents had a candid and in-depth exchange of views on China-U.S. relations, the situation in Ukraine, and other issues of mutual interest.

President Biden reiterated that the U.S. does not seek a new Cold War with China; it does not aim to change China's system; the revitalization of its alliances

is not targeted at China; the U.S. does not support "Taiwan independence"; and it has no intention to seek a conflict with China.

President Xi stressed that he and President Biden share the view that China and the U.S. need to respect each other, coexist in peace and avoid confrontation, and that the two sides should increase communication and dialogue at all levels and in all fields..

The direct cause for the current situation in the China-U.S. relationship is that some people on the U.S. side have not followed through on the important common understanding reached by the two Presidents and have not acted on President Biden's positive statements. The U.S. has misperceived and miscalculated China's strategic intention, Xi said.

The two Presidents agreed that the video call is constructive, and directed their teams to promptly follow up and take concrete actions to put China-U.S. relations back on the track of steady development.

The two leaders also exchanged views on the situation in Ukraine.

19. Chinese president stresses neighboring countries' role in supporting Afghanistan




On March 31, Chinese President Xi Jinping called on the neighboring countries of Afghanistan to do their best to support the Afghan people to create a brighter future.


Both sides agreed that the Tanzania-Zambia Railway is a powerful example of China and Africa treating each other as friends with sincerity. Efforts should be


Foreign ministers of neighboring countries attending the meeting thanked


Ambassador Chen stressed that this donation was a vivid manifestation of the

36. China's Juncao technology spells bright future for Tanzania's mushroom growers



Juncao, which in Chinese literally means "mushroom" and "grass", can be

used to grow edible and medicinal mushrooms, as livestock feed or as a green barrier to control soil erosion and stop desertification.

The Juncao technology has been developed by the National Engineering Research Center for Juncao Technology of the Fujian Agriculture and Forestry University (FAFU) of China. The technology has a multi-faceted approach of cultivating mushrooms for food and medicinal purposes while at the same time addressing soil erosion for maintaining the volume of arable land, and also supporting livestock feed development.

During the workshop on "Applications of Juncao Technology and Its Contribution to the Achievement of Sustainable Agriculture and the Sustainable Development Goals in Tanzania" organized by the United Nations Department of Economic and Social Affairs, participants visited Uyogaplus, a mushroom farm at Mabwepande in Kinondoni district on the outskirts of Dar es Salaam, on March 10.

Participants of the Uyogaplus project have been producing mushrooms by using sawdust, banana leaves, and other supplements which are very expensive. They are now in the process of adopting Juncao grass as a substitute for sawdust. Juncao grass seedlings were planted in February 2021 after supplied by the Sokoine University of Agriculture (SUA) based in Morogoro.

The Juncao technology is being championed by the Ministry of Livestock and Fisheries in Tanzania Mainland and the Ministry of Agriculture, Irrigation and Livestock in Zanzibar. Farmers and local government authorities have widely accepted the technology. There are 5,000 mushroom growers producing 1,000 tons of mushrooms annually.
