

1. Xi orders all-out rescue efforts after 6.8-magnitude earthquake in SW China



Chinese President Xi Jinping ordered all-out rescue efforts to minimize casualties after a 6.8-magnitude earthquake jolted southwest China's Sichuan Province on September 5, stressing that saving lives should be taken as the primary task.

The earthquake has left at least 21 people dead and more than 30 injured, causing damage to infrastructure facilities, such as the water and electricity supply, transportation and telecommunications.

6. China to double down on stabilizing foreign trade, foreign investment to consolidate foundation of economic recovery


China will take further measures to stabilize foreign trade and foreign investment, with a view to consolidating the foundation of economic recovery, according to the decision made at the State Council's Executive Meeting chaired by Premier Li Keqiang on Tuesday.

Noting opening-up as China's basic national policy and foreign trade a strong underpinning for stable growth and employment, the meeting underscored the imperative for redoubled efforts to stabilize foreign trade and foreign investment.

"We are facing big pressure in keeping foreign trade and foreign investment stable, with a notable slowdown of imports and exports. The first and foremost

issue is to help businesses secure orders, by using all policy measures available to the full extent, such as the China Import and Export Fair (Canton Fair), the China International Import Expo, overseas warehouses and cross-border e-commerce," Li said.

7. China's IP protection wins recognition of foreign enterprises: survey

Foreign enterprises are growing increasingly satisfied with China's intellectual property (IP) protection, a survey released by the industry watchdog showed on September 6.


Social satisfaction with the country's IP protection last year show a record high of 80.61 out of 100 points, according to the survey released by the National Intellectual Property Administration.

Zhang Zhicheng, an official with the administration, highlighted that joint ventures and foreign-funded enterprises showed scores of 4.52 points and 2.36 points higher than the figures for 2016, respectively.

The official attributed the high level of satisfaction to stronger legislation,

more effective law enforcement and more efficient IP examination.

8. China dispatches 28,000 medical personnel abroad over six decades

Over the past six decades or so, China has dispatched 28,000 medical personnel abroad to 73 countries and regions, delivering medical services for 290 million patients, according to a press conference held on September 9.

Over the past 10 years, China has redoubled its efforts in promoting health-related international exchanges, actively participated in global health governance, and contributed to the well-being of people across the world, said the conference by the National Health Commission.

Chinese medical personnel conducted free cataract and heart disease operations in over 30 countries, benefiting 22 million people. Five Chinese international emergency medical teams have been certified by the World Health Organization, and more than 2,000 medical workers on international health aid missions have gained national-level honors at home or abroad, according to the conference.

Moreover, China has contributed to the prevention and control of malaria and

the COVID-19 pandemic, and assisted West African countries in their fight against the Ebola epidemic, said the conference.

II. China's Diplomacy

9. Xi exchanges congratulations with AU chair on 20th anniversary of AU's founding, diplomatic ties

On September 9, Chinese President Xi Jinping exchanged congratulatory messages with Chairperson of the African Union (AU) and Senegalese President Macky Sall on the 20th anniversary of AU's founding and the establishment of China-AU diplomatic relations.

Xi said he attaches great importance to the development of China-AU relations, stands ready to work with President Sall and other heads of state of the AU member countries to embark from the new starting point of the 20th anniversary of the China-AU diplomatic ties, carry forward the spirit of China-Africa friendly cooperation, fully implement the outcomes of the Eighth Ministerial Conference of the Forum on China-Africa Cooperation (FOCAC), firmly support each other on issues concerning their respective core interests and major concerns, continue to increase the representation and voice of developing



13. China ready to work with Russia to support each other on issues concerning core interests: Xi


China is ready to work with Russia in extending strong support to each other on issues concerning their respective core interests, Chinese President Xi Jinping said during a meeting with his Russian counterpart, Vladimir Putin, in Samarkand, Uzbekistan on September 15.

China is also willing to deepen pragmatic cooperation in such areas as trade, agriculture and connectivity, Xi added.

He called for both sides to strengthen coordination within the Shanghai Cooperation Organization (SCO), the Conference on Interaction and Confidence

Building Measures in Asia, the BRICS and other multilateral mechanisms to promote solidarity and mutual trust among related parties.

15. Leaders of SCO member states sign Samarkand Declaration



Leaders of the Shanghai Cooperation Organization (SCO) member states on September 16 signed and released the Samarkand Declaration of the Council of Heads of State of the SCO, in Samarkand, Uzbekistan.

The 22nd meeting of the Council of Heads of State of the SCO also released a number of statements and documents on safeguarding global food security, international energy security, addressing climate change, and maintaining a secure, stable and diversified supply chain.

Based on the principles of the Charter of the Shanghai Cooperation Organization, the member states oppose grouping, and ideological and confrontational approaches to solving international and regional issues, and stick

to a coordinated manner to security threats and challenges in traditional and non-traditional fields, said the declaration.

The declaration reaffirmed that it is of great practical significance to work together to build a new type of international relations featuring mutual respect, fairness and justice as well as win-win cooperation, and to build a community with a shared future for mankind.

The member states stand for respecting the right of the people of all countries to independently choose their own paths of political, economic and social development. They stress that the principles of mutual respect for sovereignty, independence, territorial integrity, equality and mutual benefit, non-interference in internal affairs, and non-use of force or threat of force are the basis for the sustainable development of international relations.

18. Chinese FM proposes seven steps to implement Global Development Initiative



On September 20, Chinese State Councilor and Foreign Minister Wang Yi chaired the Ministerial Meeting of the Group of Friends of the Global Development Initiative (GDI) in in New York.

Wang said that as the initiator of the GDI and the largest developing country in the world, China is ready to strengthen strategic synergy with UN development agencies and work with the countries of the Group of Friends to take seven more steps to implement the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development.

First, release the first list of the GDI project pool, including 50 practical cooperation projects in such areas as poverty reduction, food security and industrialization and 1,000 more capacity building projects.

Second, advance the Food Production Enhancement Action.

Third, promote the Global Clean Energy Cooperation Partnership, deepen practical cooperation with the International Renewable Energy Agency and other countries, push for the transition to renewable energy and realize a more

sustainable energy security.

Fourth, advance cooperation on "Smart Customs, Smart Borders, Smart Connectivity," and work with such international organizations as the World Customs Organization and other countries around the world to build a smart customs network and boost connectivity of supply chains in the digital era.

Fifth, initiate a world alliance of digital education to strengthen international cooperation in this respect, energize the development of education through digitalization, and enhance the accessibility of education resources.

Sixth, launch the Bamboo as a Substitute for Plastic Initiative jointly with the International Bamboo and Rattan Organization to effectively tackle plastic pollution and give a clean and beautiful earth to future generations.

Seventh, announce China's decision to share data obtained from the satellite SDGSAT-1 it launched in November 2021 with the rest of the world to help other countries with their research and policy-making regarding sustainable development, Wang said.

19. Chinese FM expounds on right way for China, U.S. to develop relations in new era

On September 22, Chinese State Councilor and Foreign Minister Wang Yi, making a keynote speech at the headquarters of Asia Society in New York, expounded on the right way for China and the United States to develop relations in the new era.

Wang said that it is the common expectation of the international community that China and the United States play a leading role in international affairs, shoulder the responsibility undertaken by major countries, stabilize the bilateral ties and promote global cooperation.

He said that the United States repeatedly provokes China when it comes to issues related to China's core interests as well as its development rights and interests, all the while proposing that stability of the bilateral relations be maintained, that conflicts and confrontation between them be avoided.

Such acts are contradictory both logically and practically, he said.

The root cause for this inconsistency is the misperception of the United States about China, the world and itself, Wang said.



China will not become another United States, Wang stressed, adding neither is the United States able to change China based on its own likes and dislikes.

Since neither China nor the United States can knock the other over, they should respect each other's choices, he said.

China is glad to see an open, confident, developing and progressive United States, and so should the United States respect the development path chosen by the Chinese people, which is socialism with Chinese characteristics, Wang added.

In order to realize peaceful coexistence, China and the United States should abide by the rules agreed by both sides, which, on a bilateral level, are the three Sino-U.S. joint communiques and the important consensuses reached between the two leaders, rather than domestic laws imposed upon one another, and which, on a global level, are the basic norms governing international relations based on the purposes and principles of the UN Charter, Wang said.

21. China strongly condemns U.S. cyber attacks on China's Northwestern Polytechnical University



China strongly condemns the cyber attacks launched by the United States on China's Northwestern Polytechnical University, and urges the U.S. side to offer an explanation and immediately stop its unlawful moves, Foreign ministry spokesperson Mao Ning said on September 5.

It was reported that China's National Computer Virus Emergency Response Center (CVERC) and cybersecurity company 360 on September 5 respectively released investigation reports on the attacks on Northwestern Polytechnical University from the U.S. National Security Agency (NSA), which showed that the NSA-affiliated TAO mounted hundreds of thousands malicious cyber attacks

targeting Chinese objectives.

In response, Mao told a daily news briefing that the investigative reports point to another example of the U.S. government's cyber attacks on China.

22. Chinese taikonauts talk with Tanzanian students from space

Three Chinese taikonauts on September 6 talked with Tanzanian students from space via video link at an event organized by the Chinese Embassy in Tanzania.

The three Chinese Shenzhou-14 astronauts who were in space for a 6-month mission had a question and answer television live show in which they answered questions by youth across the African continent.

The event, dubbed "Connecting Heaven and Earth", was officiated by the Chinese Ambassador to Tanzania H.E. Chen Mingjian and Deputy Permanent Secretary in the Ministry of Education, Science and Technology of Tanzania Prof. James Mdoe. 24. Amb. Chen Mingjian meets with the then Tanzanian Foreign Minister Amb. Liberata Mulamula



25. Amb. Chen Mingjian pays a visit to Tanzania's National Bureau of Statistics








28. Amb. Chen Mingjian meets with Minister of Energy Mr. January Makamba


